**Footpaths Warden's Report – as at 25<sup>th</sup> November 2019**

**Footpath 1** - Bears Grove. Good.

**Footpath 4** - Heading east from Stonehouse Rd. Path still not marked out in first and second section. Great to see the style has been fixed.

**Footpath 5** - Good.

**Footpath 7** - Still narrower than previously, still need gate or some such at west end of path to hinder youths on motorcycles.

**Footpath 8** - North section clear, except as the hedge grows it pushes the walker into the barbed wire on the fence. Can we get the landowner to change it for ordinary wire? On to Vicarage Rd the style has collapsed. I moved it to one side, so people do not trip over it. Can this be replaced with a kissing gate as the current is not fit for purpose. South section demarcation is there although a little wonky.

**Footpath 11** - Broken fencing getting tatter. Overhanging ivy needs cutting now as it has finished flowering.

**Footpath 12** - Not walked this month from the road at the church looks ok.

**Footpath 14** - Not walked this path this month so nothing to add.

**Footpath 15** - Limbo time along the path 4ft clearance.

**Wroxham path FP4.** Not walked this month so cannot comment on muddy patch.

**Piggy path.** Still got the big puddle at the bottom.

**BR3.** Good.

**Other.** Concrete manhole cover situated 10m west of Jubilee Hall on the pavement of Lower St belonging to "post office telecommunications" cracked and failing.
