**Footpaths Warden's Report – none**

**Salhouse Broad Car Park and overflow Parking:**

Two complaints have been received by the Clerk from Parishioners regarding car parking on Lower Street

One report included:

25th June 2020 - An ambulance was needed at the Broad and had great difficulty in accessing it

28th June 2020 - Over 30 cars parked on the road and in entrances to fields between Pottery Business and Sladd lane.

Business proprietor having difficulty exiting business due to cars blocking entrance.
