

**HIGHWAYS AND FOOTPATHS REPORT
TO SALHOUSE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 3rd August 2020**

Footpaths Warden's Report – 30th July 2020 – Nick Ball

Footpath 1 - Bears grove. Good.

Footpath 4 - Path finally marked out. The large trough has gone. Thank you to the land tenant/owner.

Footpath 5 - Good.

Footpath 7 - Good.

Footpath 8 - Usual issues but otherwise good.

Footpath 11 - Drop away still present at north end of path. Covered area south end dry and ivy has been cut back.

Footpath 12 - Not walked this month but I assume the usual issues remain with the leylandii.

Footpath 14 - West end dry but no remedial action taken so once winter sets in problems will return.

Footpath 15 - Good, clear of tree fell.

Wroxham Footpath 4 - Dried out now but the path width has been compromised by an overenthusiastic tractor.

Piggy path - Still got the big puddle at the bottom. Fence and gate have been removed in this section giving a more open feel.

BR3 - Not walked as the last time I passed it still had those notices up. Not sure of the legality of this move by Normans Farm.

No update received regarding the footpath issues raised with NCC Footpath Officer.

FP14 missing link on definitive map – awaiting a response from correspondence sent to landowner.

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Salhouse Broad Car Park and overflow Parking:

No further complaints have been received regarding this issue.

The PC is still monitoring the problem.

Awaiting further correspondence from Salhouse Broad regarding their investigation into additional car parking.

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Wood Green Industrial Estate:

Parishioner email received regarding rubbish on Wood Green Industrial Estate attracting vermin – under investigation.

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Footpath on Salhouse Recreation Ground:

It has been agreed by Salhouse United Charities Trust to submit a deposit with Norfolk County Council. This agreement would be in place for 20 years so no-one can show evidence that it can become a public right of way. It has to be renewed every 20 years. The permissive path itself can be withdrawn at any time by the landowner.
