**Lower Street parking issues** – ongoing monitoring of this situation.

Concerns have been raised regarding the parking around the Lower Street/Upper Street green triangle, however it has been explained that Highways will not support parking restrictions and the PC have investigated wooden posts on several occasions, which have also not been supported by Highways.
