Highways Updates

Hall Drive – Meeting held between Highways and Flood and Water Management representative on 21st January 2022. Highways to investigate further the drain network leading from Bell pond down Lower Street. Landowner to clear ditches further up Hall Drive to help with drainage.

Howlett's Loke – Meeting held between Highways and Flood and Water Management representative on 21st January 2022. Works carried out on February to clear ditches and improve Highways verge. To be monitored.

Damaged signage – Reported to Highways Ranger 23/11/21 and Highways direct 06/01/22.

Lower Street 30mph sign – new post installed

Norwich Road damaged sign opposite 68 Norwich Road – sign reinstated

Finger post sign opposite Station Road – finger posts have been ordered by Highways and will be reinstated once received.

Howletts Loke nameplate (Station Road end) – BDC aware this is missing and will reorder/install.

Missing link Footpath 14 – with NCC and landowner.

Cheyney Avenue Verges – verges to be reseeded. Investigate further other options for verge improvements.
