Footpaths Warden's Report – no report this month

Footpath 1 - Bears grove. Good.

Footpath 4 - Path well marked out, although no evidence of much use, sad that these paths go nowhere.

Footpath 8 - Across field has been well laid out in furrow, lot of wildflowers along the edge. Also, good to see a border of 6m or so around the edge of the field hopefully left fallow. Once again, the barbed wire fence is too close to the path. Whilst walking I collided with the fence a couple of times avoiding the burdock heads and stingers.

Footpath 11 - Great to see the removal of the hideous fence. The screws that protruded through the fence are also gone. Well done to the new owners of School Farm. The ivy hedge alongside the paddocks needs urgent cutting.

Footpath 12 - Not walked this month.

Footpath 14 - Path by the stables has been dealt with looking good so far. Midsection, care needs to be taken as furrow comes too close to the path in places.

Footpath 15 - Not walked this month. Section on bell lane looking ok.

Wroxham path FP4 - Not walked this month but I surmise nothing has happened.

Piggy path - Good. We need a new footpath finger board and post at the Vicarage Road end.
